The IHRSA Passport Program entitles members of participating clubs to receive guest privileges at any of the participating clubs worldwide when they travel. As a condition of participation, clubs must commit to offering **at least 50% off the regular guest fee.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PASSPORT GUEST:

1. Complete the information below.
2. Visit healthclubs.com/passport to locate a club that participates in the IHRSA Passport Program.
3. **Call the club in advance** to verify any guest fees that may apply as well as to confirm the availability of the facilities you intend to use.
4. Upon arrival, present this Passport Guest Pass to the front desk, pay the guest fee and you're in!

NOTES TO HOST CLUB:

- As a participant in the IHRSA Passport Program, your club has agreed to discount your regular guest fee by at least 50% for members of other participating clubs.
- Passport guests should be treated with the same respect as you would treat your own members.
- For your protection, always ask for proper identification from your Passport guests.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS ABOUT THE PASSPORT PROGRAM:

- The IHRSA Passport Program is not intended for temporary membership privileges, or for transferring a membership. It is designed for use on a short-term visitation basis only.
- Passport guests may only visit clubs that are located at least 50 miles/80 kilometers away from your home club.
- Passport guests must honor each club's rules and regulations regarding guest fees, guest hours, visitation frequency, etc.
- Not all IHRSA clubs choose to participate in the program, but only IHRSA clubs are eligible.
